The Planner[™] Table Series is part of a relaunched Fritz Hansen collection by Paul McCobb, a legendary designer known for creating slender designs where form follows function. Featuring a structured marble surface and a powder-coated steel base, the tables are an illustration of raw, tactile simplicity.

ABOUT THE DESIGNER

Paul McCobb's (1917-1969) innate understanding of perspective paved the way for a career as one of the most important design figures of his time. The self-taught designer's pragmatic yet perfectionist nature was reflected in his work, characterised by slender, graphic lines, a simplicity of form and lightness of design. His trademark scale and perspective imbued his no-nonsense designs, which focused on simplicity and functionality, pared back to their purest forms.

MATERIAL

Tabletop: The tabletop comes in two kind of marbles. Each tabletop has a matt, consistent, and uniform honed surface. Every piece of marble is unique and no two pieces will be identical. All types of marble will have various veining and crystallization that might appear to be cracks or pits.

The Charcoal marble has a fine-grained compact structure that is characterised by its deep black colour and striking white veining. The stone contains fossils from shells, snails, etc. which furthermore underlines the uniqueness of each slab.

The Cream marble has a fine-grained compact structure that is characterised by its cream base colour and red veining pattern, caused by different metal minerals being accumulated in the earth's crust 100,000,000 years ago where the stone is now quarried. Other features are brown fossil sediments and white marbling, formed primarily from calcite. **Base:** The base is made of 12 mm TIG-welded steel rod. The tabletop is supported by flat steel bars. The feet of the base are made of pressure casted zinc and they are glued to the frame. The entire base is powder coated in matt black (RAL 9005, gloss 10-15).

The tabletop is available in 2 colours:



MADE-TO-ORDER

Non-standard configurations (special colours etc.) are available upon request at a minimum order quantity.

PRODUCTION PROCESS

Tabletop: Marble slabs are machine polished two times before being cut into the different table sizes. Each table top is then polished by hand two times to achieve the matte honed surface.

Base: Solid steel rods are CNC-cut and welded together. Weldings are then polished to create a smooth transition. Feet are pressure-casted in zinc. The entire base is then powder coated.

PACKAGING

The tabletop is packed in plastic and Styrofoam, and finally packed inside cradles of solid wood. All wood are fumigated before packaging.

The base is shipped in a cardboard box. Inside the box the base is covered with a plastic bag and protected by PE foam. All packaging material can be recycled.

Extended: 10 years (Base, Tabletop)


On any material, fabric or leather, which is not listed in our price list on a specific product, the standard warranty is 2 years.







